Hurricane season is here! May 15 – November 30**

Please be sure to stock up on the following items to ensure your safety and comfort:

- 30-day supply of all medications
- 7 galls of drinking water per person
- Canned meats (tuna, chicken, Spam)
- Canned fruit and vegetables
- Fruit juices
- Peanut butter
- Crackers
- Powdered or evaporated milk
- Prepared food (soup, spaghetti, chili)
- Disposable plates, cups, and utensils
- Toilet paper
- Pet food and water for pets – cat litter
- Soap
- Bleach
- Insect Repellent
- Portable radio
- Flashlight
- Extra batteries
- Waterproof matches
- Manual can opener
- Propane (if you have a gas grill) or charcoal & lighter fluid
- Make or buy bags of ice to store in your freezer
- First Aid kit
- Fire extinguisher
- Plastic garbage bags
- Cash (if power is out ATMs won't work)
- Important papers / documents if you evacuate – including medical info for family and pets.
